INSTRUCTOR: Dr. Berry was born and raised in Alberta, Canada. He completed his pre-medicine requisites at the University of Calgary and went on to complete his Doctorate at Parker University in Dallas, Texas. He graduated Magna Cum Laude, Salutatorian and was the recipient of many academic awards including the Parker Scholastic Excellence Award. Upon completion of his Doctor of Chiropractic, Dr. Berry attended the Carrick Institute for Graduate Studies. Dr. Berry has traveled throughout North America and Europe attending neurology conferences and modules to obtain the most recent information in the field of functional neurology. He became a board certified Chiropractic Neurologist in 2001 upon passing the American Chiropractic Neurology board examination. He has over 2000 post-doctoral hours in the study of Neurology.

INSTRUCTOR: Dr. Brandon Brock is a clinician in Dallas, Texas who holds a doctorate in Family Nursing Practice from Duke University. He has returned back to Duke for continued training and specialization in orthopedics and also has a specialized fellowship training in stem cell technology and regenerative medicine. In Dallas he serves as a chief clinician at Foundations Physicians Group and Brock Integrative Medicine.
